

# Plastic Free July: Some More Ideas

Save Soft fruit Punnets: Reuse them as seed trays for planting seedlings instead of small plastic pots. Use toilet roll tubes in the same way.

Buy a reusable coffee cup: Even cardboard disposable cups are lined with plastic, making them hard to recycle. Also, many cafes offer a discount if you bring your own cup.

Lose the Wet Wipes: Use washable cotton cloths to wipe kitchen or bathroom surfaces.

Ditch the Cling Film: Put a plate on top of a bowl of cut vegetables or leftovers in the fridge to keep them fresh, or use kitchen foil.

And Finally: Use what you have at the moment for as long as possible. When the time comes to replace things, look for non-plastic alternatives. You will be surprised what you can get in metal, wood and glass.
