There are now sheets at the back of church so that you can list any deceased members of your family and friends.


Each Mass during November we will remember those listed and pray for them. The basket will remain on the altar through the whole month.

New Missal. There is a new missal which will come into use on the 1st Sunday of Advent this year. This means all the readings will change. If you have a personal missal it will mean you will need to invest in a new one, and they are rather expensive; Redemptorist Publications are offering them at £19.99. An alternative is (if you have a smart phone) to invest in an app called Universalis. This app has all the readings for every day of the year as well as the Office of the hours and many other devotions. I think it is £9.99, just something to think about.

The Sacred Heart Web site has "Today's Readings of the Day" using the Universalis app so you can always refer to that.
