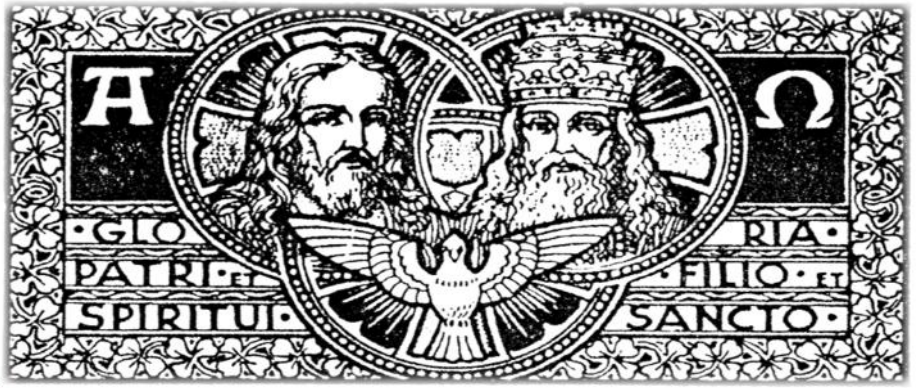

### Sacred Heart & St. William's Move into the Diocese of Salford.

I have spoken with the powers that be, regarding the time scale as to when the move from the Leeds Diocese into the Salford Diocese might happen. Apparently, everything is now in place and Bishop John Arnold, needs to write to the Pro Nuncio for things to move forward. He needed to put this proposal to both the council of priests and then to the Trustees, these two agenda items have now been completed, and Bishop John has sent the letter to the Pro Nuncio this week, now it is a waiting game; from what I have heard it should not take too long for things to progress.

Bishop John would also like to come to address the parish when the time is right, I will let you know when this is to happen in plenty of time.
