### **Green issues – to make you think – Food Waste.**

A third of the food intended for human consumption – around 1.3 billion tons – is wasted or lost. This is enough to feed 3 billion people. Food waste and loss account for approximately one-quarter of greenhouse gas emissions annually; if it was a country, food waste would be the <u>third-largest emitter</u> of greenhouse gases, behind China and the US. We all throw away too much food.
